Pursuant to EU Regulation 2016/679, this privacy notice confirms that the company GOINGGREENTRANSLATIONS di Fabiano Gambacorta, with headquarters at Via Cona, 18, Teramo, Italy, as DATA CONTROLLER, acquires and processes the personal data provided by completing the "WORK WITH US" "FORM" on the website www.goinggreentranslations.com. Therefore, by clicking the "Send" button upon completion of the form, you confirm that you have read and understood this notice and provide, where requested, your consent to the processing of your personal data for the specific purposes indicated below. Specifically, all of the data requested from you is required to assess your application. You have the option of attaching your CV in PDF format. This notice concerns both the data gathered before or during the recruitment process, by applying for one of the positions available in the "Work with Us" area of the website, or when the Data Subject sends their Curriculum Vitae ("CV") directly and voluntarily via: a web page provided by the Data Controller. In all cases, where personal data is received at the personal initiative of the Data Subject (by voluntarily sending their CV) or collected via third parties, the data to which this notice refers is supplied at the moment of the first useful contact following the sending of the CV, in accordance with article 111 bis of Italian Legislative Decree 196/2003.

1. Purposes and legal basis for processing the data (article 13, paragraph 1, letter c) of EU Regulation 2016/679)

Personal data is collected and processed exclusively in order to:

- a) receive your application for a potential business relationship with our company (either as an employee or an external partner)
- b) contact you in the event we are interested in your application
- c) create a company database to draw on for any future needs the company may have (with consent)
- d) process, at the discretion of the Data Controller, sensitive data sent voluntarily by the candidate (with consent)
- 2. Data processing principles (article 5 et seq. of EU Regulation 2016/679)

The data acquired and/or provided by you will be processed in an HONEST, LAWFUL and TRANSPARENT manner, PROTECTING THE DATA SUBJECT'S RIGHTS AND PRIVACY and in general protecting your privacy and rights.

3. Retention period (article 13, paragraph 2, letter a) of EU Regulation 2016/679)

The data will be stored for 36 months from the time it is entered into the system, or from the time it is updated by the user, after which it will be deleted automatically. If, however, you should enter into a business relationship with our company, the data will be stored for the full duration of the working relationship and, on its conclusion, for a further 10 years, to protect our legitimate interests in the event of disputes.

3. Data processing methods and location

Your data is processed for the purposes set out under point 1 above using both automated methods in electronic format and non-automated methods on paper, in compliance with the rules on privacy and security set out in current legislation, any resulting regulations and internal rules.

Your CV will be retained in full in the format in which you send it. We therefore recommend you delete from it any information not relevant to the business relationship offered. In all cases, our company will only use the information required to assess your application. The Data Subject is advised not to send sensitive information to the Data Controller. 8. Rights of the data subject

16 of EU Regulation 2016/679) and delete, anonymise or freeze data processed unlawfully, including data that does not need to be stored for the purposes for which the data was gathered and subsequently processed, the so-called "right to be forgotten" (article 17 of EU Regulation 2016/679); e) request limits be placed on the processing of your personal data (article 18 of EU Regulation 2016/679); f) receive confirmation that the operations as per letters a) and b), including in relation to their contents, have been brought to the attention of the entities to which the data was communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the right that is to be protected; g) oppose, in full or in part, for legitimate reasons, the processing of your personal data, including in relation to the purposes of its collection (article 21 of EU Regulation 2016/679); h) the portability of your personal data (article 20 of EU Regulation 2016/679), provided it falls within the scope of data for which portability is allowed.
